privately engaged, and brought away from Italy, some of the Mem shat were employed at the Pope's Allum Works near Rome, who first taught us the Art of making Allum here in England, and set these Works a-going, which are yet to be seen at Guisbro. This Affair so much exosperated his tioliness, that he denounced against these Fingitives, and all who were any Way concerned in carrying them off, the following most dreadful Gurse.

Y the Authority of God Almighty, the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. And as Fire is quenched with Water, so let their Light be put out for evermore, unless they shall repent, and make Satisfaction. Amen.

May the Father, who created Man, curse them. May the Son, who suffered for us, curse them. May the Holy Ghost, who was given to us in Baptism. curse them. May the Holy Cross, which Christ for our Salvation, triumphing over his Enemy, ascended, curse them. May the Holy and Eternal Virgin Mary, Mother of God, curse them. May St. Michael, the advocate of Holy Souls, curse them. May all the Angels and Archangels, Principalities and Powers, and all the heavenly Host, curse them. May the laudable Number of the Patriarchs and Prophets, curse them. May St. John, the chief Fore-runner and Baptism of Christ, curse them. May St. Peter, and St. Paul, and St. Andrew, and all other Christ's Apostles, together with the Rest of his Disciples, and sour Evangelists, who by their Preaching converted the universal World, curse them. May the Holy and wonderful Company of Martyrs and Confessors, who by their Hely Works are found pleasing to God Almighty, curse them. May the Holy Choir of the Holy Virgins, who for the Honour of Christ have despised. the Things of the World, curse them.
